The Physiotherapist is a member of a professional health discipline, whose training and knowledge qualify him/her to make decisions and accept responsibility for all aspects of physiotherapy patient care. The physiotherapist provides effective and efficient physiotherapy services to patients referred to the Parkland Regional Therapy Services within available resources. This position is a combined adult and pediatric physiotherapy position with .5 of the therapist's time dedicated to the Parkland Children's Therapy initiative and the .5 of the time dedicated to adult services based out of the Swan Valley Health Centre. Physiotherapy services for adults will be provided in hospitals, personal care homes, health centers, and within the community as required. Pediatric services will be based in the community at client's homes, daycares and schools.

As a member of an interdisciplinary team, the physiotherapist is primarily involved in the physiotherapy aspects of assessment, intervention, program planning and implementation, discharge planning and follow-up of referred patients. In addition, the physiotherapist is involved in education of patient, family and/or significant other, other health disciplines, auxiliary staff, and the general public, with regard to physiotherapy treatment, the management of patient's health problems, and preventative physiotherapy techniques.

Qualifications:

- A degree in physiotherapy from an approved university.
- Current registration with the College of Physiotherapists of Manitoba.
- Eligible for membership with the Canadian Physiotherapy Association.
- Experience in pediatrics and adult services preferred.
- Province of Manitoba Class 5 Drivers license and access to a personal vehicle to provide services within the Parkland Regional Health Authority.
