Occupational Therapy Services will be provided in Hospitals, Personal Care Homes, Health Centers, client's residents, and community centers as required.

As a member of a multidisciplinary team, the Occupational Therapist is primarily involved in the Occupational Therapy aspects of assessment, intervention, program planning and implementation, discharge planning and follow-up of referred patients. In addition, the Occupational Therapist is involved in education of patients and their family and/or significant other, other health care disciplines, auxiliary staff, and the general public, with regard to Occupational Therapy treatment, the management of patient's health problems, and preventive Occupational Therapy techniques.
