Under the general supervision of the Clinical Service Manager, and while demonstrating a commitment to the Mission, Values and Management Philosophy of PRHA, the Clinical Resource Nurse organizes and coordinates the functions of the Surgical Suite, PACU and Pre-operative clinics, by coordinating the slating process, the development of nursing proposals for nursing care and the selection and evaluation of equipment and supplies. Also performing charge nurse functions; networking with physicians and performing other related duties as assigned.

The Nurse IV recognizes and fulfills professional responsibilities by practicing within the Registered Nurses Act, the approval of College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba (CRNM) Standards of Nursing Practice and the Canadian Nurses Association (CNA) Code of Ethics for Nursing.

Qualifications:

- Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing preferred.
- Current active registration with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba.
- Certified Perioperative Nurse Designation or Completion of a Perioperative Nursing Course or Completion of the Dauphin Regional Health Centre in-house perioperative training program.
- A minimum of three (3) years within the past five (5) years perioperative nursing experience
- Formal training/education in specific clinical specialty areas of supervision, or other combination of education and experience will be considered.
- Evidence of Management and / or Nursing Leadership Education.
- Demonstrated experience in program development and program evaluation.
- Demonstrated ability to foster interdisciplinary collaborative environment that supports quality services, quality improvement and staff empowerment
- Current basic cardiac life support certification.
- Demonstrated conflict resolution skills.
