"Hidden Hugs"

You and your child are involved in a car accident and you are knocked unconscious. Your child is in their car seat in the back. Paramedics arrive at the scene and begin treating you and your child. You are still unconscious and unable to relay any information about your child to the medics. Who will speak for your child? Who will tell the medics or hospital staff of any allergies or medical conditions your child has? Who will even know your child's name?



With a **Hidden Hugs Car Seat Emergency Information Kit** attached to your child's car seat, all the important information is easily accessible in an emergency situation. Your child's personal information, medical conditions, allergies and medications are included on the card, as well as the parent/guardian's names and emergency contact names.

The **Hidden Hugs Kit** is simple to use, and comes with everything you need. All you have to do is fill out the information card and put it in the included envelope. Attach the envelope to the rear of your child's car seat and place the sticker on the Driver's side of the rear window.

In an emergency, the **Hidden Hugs** sticker on your window will alert the Responding Emergency service that there is a Car Seat Information Kit on your child's car seat. For such a small sticker, it can give you a lot of piece of mind.
