Parkland prepares for Philippine nurse recruitment mission

Dauphin- The Parkland Regional Health Authority (PRHA) is embarking on one of the largest recruitment efforts it has ever undertaken as it prepares representatives to travel to the Philippines on a provincial nursing recruitment initiative. The PRHA will partner with the Province of Manitoba and Labour and Immigration in an effort to recruit 30 full-time nurses to the Parkland area. The PRHA travel team will be in the Philippines to conduct interviews from November 10-14th, joining three other RHAs that are involved in the provincial initiative.
