PRHA pleased with MNU announcement

Dauphin- The Parkland Regional Health Authority (PRHA) has received notification from the Manitoba Nurses Union (MNU) that the ‘*Greylisting*’ status of Dauphin Regional Health Centre (DRHC) has been lifted. Although the PRHA is not able to comment on specifics of the MNU vote to lift the sanction, it is extremely pleased by the announcement.

“The PRHA, Manitoba Health and Healthy Living, the Manitoba Nurses Union and local nurses have collaborated to improve workplace issues identified at Dauphin Regional Health Centre,” stated Allan Bradley, Chief Executive Officer of Parkland Regional Health Authority.

“The PRHA’s commitment towards quality improvement and patient safety at the DRHC, and all of its facilities, remains at the very forefront of our day to day activities. We look forward to continuing to work with all of our stakeholders and partners to enhance health care services within our Region.”

Both the PRHA and local nursing union used the services of a provincial mediator to jointly address worksite challenges. Specific goals and action plans related to workloads, work environments and working relationships at DRHC were developed and implemented.

“Most importantly, the PRHA is committed towards enhancing working relationships in a positive and constructive manner between its leadership team and all staff. By working together we can sustain quality treatment and care for all patients, residents and clients within the Parkland Region,” Bradley added.
