



Are You Being Referred to an Out of Town Specialist?

Telehealth sites in **Dauphin, Grandview, McCreary, Roblin, Ste. Rose, and Swan River** may give the specialist the option of seeing you by two-way video.

Why use Telehealth?

- Decreases time away from home and work
- Reduces travel
- Saves you time, money and risks associated with travel
- Improves access to specialized services that may not be currently available in your home community

Consultation Process for MB Telehealth

- Complete referral letter/consultation following normal practice, including client demographics and complete history
- Indicate on the consultation that if possible, client would prefer consultation to be done via Telehealth at **Dauphin, Grandview, McCreary, Roblin, Ste. Rose, and Swan River**
- Client will be notified by the specialist office of appointment date, time and location
- Following the Telehealth session, a copy of the completed consultation will be sent to the referring physician
